Title

Texts: Please write in English (Calibri, 12 p.) The editor is happy to discuss and agree any corrections or alterations that might be needed so we have consistency and clarity. Length: 2,000 – 3,000 words.

This is not an academic text, but references as end notes can be included.

Images: Please send high-quality colour digital image (300 dpi minimum) that will illustrate the text. The photo will be placed on the same page as the text. Supply a short caption for the photo, and include the name of the photographer (if different to the author). *Submission of the photo implies permission to reproduce in this publication only.*

References: Format following ISO 690 is:

- [1] SURNAME, Name: *Publication title*. Place: Publisher, year of publication.
- [2] SURNAME, Name: Paper title. *Periodical title*, publication date, volume, issue, pages.

Biographical summary: Please send a brief biographical note of max 100 words, eg.:

“Michael Hever is professor of industrial history at the Institute for Applied Research in Rotterdam and secretary of the Dutch mining history association. He coordinated the first international inventory of mining sites, www.intermine.com, and has advised UNESCO on World Heritage Sites. His most recent publication is *Mining and miners*, and his research interests include 19th century coal mines and the impact of immigration on industrialisation in Holland.”
